Important Dates

- **Recital Tickets go on sale on Monday, April 29th at 10:00am**
- Shows and Show Orders are listed on Page 2 & 3!
- Costumes will be distributed no later than the week of June 3rd
- Pictures will take place before and during the recital on June 15th. Please reference page 4 for more details!
- **Dance recital is Saturday, June 15th. We will have 2 different shows this year. Dancer call time is 30 minutes before their performance!**

Ticket Information

- Tickets go on sale Monday, April 29th
- All tickets are sold through the Lone Tree Performing Arts Center. The easiest way is to order online, however they also can help you over the phone and in person!
- The ticket link will be sent out the morning they go on sale!
- Tickets are assigned seating.
- If your dancer is in multiple shows, you do need to purchase tickets for both shows if you want to watch them perform!
- Jr. Academy Dance Classes will perform on stage in alphabetical order by last name. It's not an exact science, but dancers with "a" last names (at the beginning of the alphabet) will be placed onto the performer's stage right (if you are sitting in the audience looking at the stage, this would be the left side of the stage).
- Tickets will be available to purchase at the door, if available.
- There is no limit on the number of tickets you can purchase.
- Ticket prices vary by seating section and age (lap child v. adult). **ALL PERSONS REGARDLESS OF AGE NEED A TICKET IN ORDER TO ENTER THE THEATER!** We recommend leaving babies at home! Dancers who are performing in the show do NOT need a ticket – only people who are there to watch and enjoy (:

Show Information

- The recital will take place at the Lone Tree Arts Center (<http://www.lonetreeartscenter.org/>) located at 10075 Commons Street, Lone Tree CO, 80124.
- Each show will last approximately one hour and 25 minutes. There will NOT be an intermission during any of the shows.
- Dancer call time is 30 mins prior to the show starting. We will not take students backstage any earlier!

- All performers should arrive ready to perform with hair and make-up done. Dancers should be dressed in their first routine's costume. (Minus their shoes – no tap shoes are allowed in the lobby or dressing rooms!) The show order will be sent out soon!
- Dancer drop off will be located in the theater lobby.
- Company dancers will utilize the downstairs dressing rooms. Parents are NOT allowed to come downstairs to help them set up their items. If you want to be allowed downstairs, you must be an official volunteer. Make sure your dancer is prepped ahead of time on how to set up their items.
- Dancer pick up will be in the theater lobby. More info will be sent on this when it gets closer but please be patient and do not swarm the check-out table!
- Company dancers will be released directly into the theater lobby – please be patient as they have a lot to carry and there is only one elevator! If any company dancers are performing in both shows, they are allowed to leave their items in the dressing rooms during the break.
- Non-company, recreational dancers will only be allowed to bring one bag with them to the recital which will be provided to them. If their items don't fit into the bag, then please don't bring them! We will have plenty of activities, movies, and games to keep kids occupied back stage! Everything you bring must be labeled with your dancer's name. Lost items are not the responsibility of MHDC.
- A professional will be recording the show. All digital files will be emailed in early July with downloadable links.

Hair & Make Up

Hair Styles are different for combo students vs. all other dancers!

Combo Students: All combo students (classes that are either ages 2-3, 3-4, 4-6 or 6-8) can choose their favorite hair style for this performance! We highly recommend pulling at least the top portion of the hair back so that it is out of your dancer's face. Feel free to use (or not use!) any hair accessories that might come with your dancer's specific costume.

Level 1 Students and Up (including team): All students should have a center part, low pony tail! Here is a video tutorial in case you need help! <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=e21cXfJUPCo>

Make Up:

Make up is not required for your dancer but highly recommended! We suggest a light layer of powder or foundation, a rosy blush, a neutral eye shadow, mascara and a light pink lip!

Recital Pictures

Recital Picture Day will take place before and during the recital, at Lone Tree Arts Center! Participation is optional, but we would love to see as many dancers as possible!

New this year! Instead of the traditional (and sometimes stale!) posed photos, we will have a FREE 360 photobooth! Feel free to use it as much as you like with your dancer, their friends, and your family!

Please wear your **full recital costume**. If you are in more than one dance, we recommend coming in your first costume, but if you prefer a photo in a different costume, feel free to quickly change!

Dancers should arrive for photos no more than 1 hour prior to show time. Photos are taken first come, first serve! If there is a long line, you can always decide to take your photos AFTER the show as well! The photo booth will be open all day from 9:30am – 2:30pm.
